# **Sexually Violent Predator's Placement Hearing Date March 6, 2020**

The hearing date for the proposed placement of Sexually Violent Predator (SVP) Michael Poulosom will be held on:

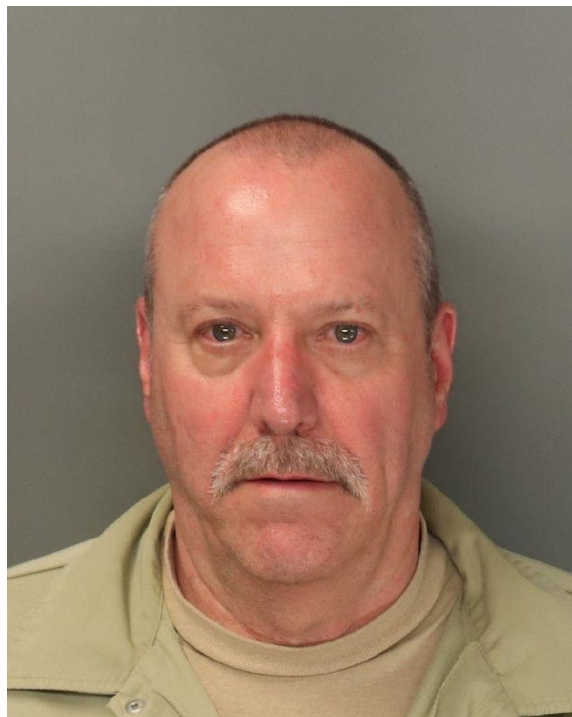

On December 24, 2019, the Department of State Hospitals (DSH) proposed the placement of SVP Michael Poulsom at 45612 Old Highway 80, Jacumba Hot Springs, CA 91934. Poulsom was convicted in the 1990's of committing lewd and lascivious acts with a child under 14. Selection of the proposed placement location is the sole responsibility of DSH and the San Diego County Superior Court. However, under Welfare & Institutions Code section 6609.1, the public is permitted to comment on the proposed location before it is finalized by the court.

Jacumba Hot Springs, California, is an unincorporated community in the southeastern area of San Diego County. Per the United States Census, the population of Jacumba Hot Springs, formerly known as Jacumba, was 561 in 2010, while the neighboring community of Boulevard had a population of 315 during the same time period. The property of interest is located within the San Diego County Sheriff Department's jurisdiction. The area is patrolled by deputies assigned to the Boulevard / Jacumba Sheriff's Office. This facility is staffed by resident deputies who live and work in the area.

With the court hearing scheduled for March 6, 2020, the SAFE Task Force will again be accepting public comments about the proposed placement to be included in the formal response to the Court.

The Sheriff's Department, District Attorney's Office and SAFE Task Force are not responsible for the selection of the proposed site. The selection process is the responsibility of the Department of State Hospitals and San Diego Superior Court.

You may submit your comments through any of the methods listed below. Public comments will be accepted between the dates of January 31, 2020, and February 13, 2020. These comments will be forwarded to DSH and to the Superior Court before the hearing on this matter. Public comments will also be accepted at the hearing.
