San Diego County District Attorney Adds 24 New Prosecutors to its Ranks

Diverse Class Includes Combat War Veteran, Athletes, and Musicians

The [San Diego County District Attorney's Office](#) announced the addition of 24 Deputy District Attorneys who were sworn in today at the Hall of Justice. The diverse group includes 14 women and 10 men who come from across the state and country. Their varied backgrounds include experience working as graduate law clerks at various District Attorneys' Offices across the state of California, as well as attorneys with prosecution experience at the San Diego City Attorney's Office.

The group recently completed two weeks of training under the guidance of senior Deputy District Attorneys to learn more about the functions of the San Diego DA's Office and hone essential trial advocacy skills. The new prosecutors report to their assignments today across all four branches and various divisions of the District Attorney's Office.
