6 in Department 18, on June 1, 2000. Deputy District Attorney Terri A. Perez appeared as
7 attorney for plaintiff, the People of the State of California, and it appearing that Defendants:

23 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** that
24 defendants JUAN ALVAREZ (aka “Spikey); JULIAN ARROYO (aka “Prieto”); LUIS
25 ARROYO (aka “Patas”); OSMID ARROYO (aka “Zombie”); DANIEL CHAVEZ (aka
26 “Yogi”); JAIME CHAVEZ (aka “Grumpy”); CARLOS DOMINGUEZ (aka “Crow”);
27 MARCO ESTRADA (aka “Phantom”); OSCAR ESTRADA (aka “Tito”); DAVID
28 FIGUEROA (aka “Beaver”); RAMIRO FLORES (aka “Ramy”/ “Flaco”); JOSE GARCIA
(aka “Chico”); CASTOR HINOJOSA (aka “George”/ “Goofy”); GEORGE MOLINA (aka
“Hefty”); EZEQUIEL NAVARRO (aka “Zeke”); JAIME NAVARRO (aka “Bones”); ERIC

5 LAUREANO ZAVALA (aka “Capone”); and VARRIO MESA LOCOS, its members,
6 agents, servants, and employees, and all persons acting under, in concert with, or from any of
7 them, **SHALL BE PERMANENTLY ENJOINED FROM** engaging in or performing
8 directly, or indirectly, any of the following activity in the Target Area (bounded by Libby
9 Lake Park to the North, North River Road to the South, Calle Vallecitos to the East and Calle
10 Montecito to the West)(See Exhibit A, attached):

- 11 a. Standing, sitting, walking, driving, bicycling, gathering or appearing
12 anywhere in public view with any other defendant herein, or with any other known Varrio
13 Mesa Locos member;
- 14 b. Drinking or possessing alcoholic beverages, using drugs in public, being
15 under the influence of alcohol or drugs, in public;
- 16 c. Possessing any weapons: knives, rocks, bottles, bricks, sticks, clubs,
17 firearms, or any other instrument prohibited by Penal Code section 12020.
- 18 d. Engaging in fighting in public streets, alleys, and/or public and private
19 property, including Libby Lake Park;
- 20 e. Using or possessing marker pens, spray paint cans, nails, razor blades,
21 or other sharp objects capable of defacing private or public property;
- 22 f. Spray painting or otherwise applying graffiti on any public or private
23 property, including but not limited to the street, alley, residences, block walls, vehicles
24 and/or any other real or personal property;
- 25 g. Trespassing on or encouraging others to trespass on any private
26 property;
- 27 h. Blocking the free passage of any person or vehicle on any street,
28 walkway, sidewalk, driveway, alleyway, or other area of public passage;
- i. Discharging any firearms;

- 1 j. In any manner confronting, intimidating, annoying, harassing,
2 threatening, challenging, provoking, assaulting and/or battering any residents or patrons or
3 visitors to the Target Area, or any other persons who are know to have complained about
4 gang activities;
- 5 k. Causing or participating in the use, possession and/or sale of
6 narcotics/drugs, including marijuana;
- 7 l. Owning, possessing or driving a vehicle found to have any contraband,
8 drugs, or illegal or deadly weapons;
- 9 m. Possessing burglar tools, including rocks, slim jims, spark plugs or other
10 devices capable of being used to break into locked vehicles;
- 11 n. Signaling to, whistling, or acting as a lookout for other persons to warn
12 of the approach of police officers;
- 13 o. Littering in any public place or place open to public view;
- 14 p. Urinating on any public or private property open to public view;
- 15 q. Using words, phrases, physical gestures, or symbols, commonly known
16 as hand signs or engaging in other forms of communication which describe or refer to the
17 gang known as Varrio Mesa Locos (VML); such as: placing the separating two fingers to
18 form a “V”, or placing elbows together to form a “V”; extending three fingers to form a “M”;
19 and extending the index finger and thumb to form a “L”;
- 20 r. Wearing clothing, or accessories, which bear the name, initials, letters,
21 numbers or other symbols of the gang known as Varrio Mesa Locos (VML), including:
22 “VML”; “ML”; “MESA”; “MM”; “VMLS”; “13 12”; and “13”;
- 23 s. Making, causing, or encouraging others to make loud noise of any kind,
24 including, but not limited to, yelling and loud music at any time of the day or night;
- 25 t. If under the age of eighteen (18), being in a public place between the
26 hours of 10:00 p.m. on any day, and sunrise of the immediately following day, unless (1)
27 accompanied by a parent or legal guarding, or by a spouse eighteen (18) years of age or
28 older, or (2) performing an errand directed by a parent or legal guarding, or by a spouse
eighteen (18) years of age or older, or (3) returning directly home from a public meeting, or a

1 place of public entertainment, such as a movie, play, sporting event, dance or school activity,
2 or (4) actively engaged in some business, trade, professionalism, or occupation which
3 requires such presence;

4 u. If eighteen (18) years of age or older, being in a public place between
5 midnight on any day and sunrise of the immediately following day, unless (1) going to/from
6 a legitimate meeting or entertaining activity, or (2) actively engaged in some business, trade,
7 profession, or occupation which requires such presence.
