ABATE A PUBLIC NUISANCE**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

Sergio Arroyo (aka Speedy); Manuel Avila (aka Rascal); Ignacio Banuelos (aka Nacho);

1 Juan Banuelos (aka Vampy); David Englebrecht (aka Trigger); Eric Flores (aka Little E); Jose
2 Gallardo (aka Silent); Juan Gamino (aka Tico); Roman Garcia (aka Junior); Richard Jaime (aka
3 Chato); Richard Jaime, Jr. (aka Lil' Mo); Juan Luevanos (aka Lil' Cisco); Manuel Luis
4 Manriquez (aka Scrappy); Danny Massett (aka Crook); Juan Medina (aka Cisco); Roberto
5 Medina (aka Bullet); Thomas Medina (aka Shaggy); Armando Morales (aka Snoopy); Jesse
6 Patrick Moreno (aka Mosco); Alex Robles (aka Spooky); Julio Rodriguez (aka Sniper); Abel
7 Salgado (aka Shadow); Miguel Sandoval (aka Puma); Octavio Serna (aka Bam Bam); Mario Soto

9 Drowsy); Posole, its members, agents, servants, and employees, and all persons acting under, in
10 concert with, or from any of them, **SHALL BE PERMANENTLY ENJOINED FROM**
11 engaging in any of the following activity in the Target Area (bounded by Interstate 5 to the west;
12 the 1400, 1500 and 1600 blocks of Mission Ave. to the south; the 200 block of Canyon Dr. to
13 the east; and state route 76 to the north, inclusive).

14 a. Standing, sitting, walking, driving, bicycling, or gathering anywhere in public
15 view with any other defendant herein, or with any other known Posole gang member. This
16 prohibition shall not apply to named defendants living in the target area on November 25,
17 1997, who are father and sons/daughters, mothers/sons/daughters;

18 b. Drinking alcoholic beverages, being under the influence of
19 or using drugs in public;

20 c. Possessing any weapons: knives; clubs; concealed or loaded firearms;
21 baseball bats; glass bottles; or any other instrument prohibited by Penal Code Section 12020.

22 d. Engaging in fighting in the public streets, alleys, and/or public and private
23 property;

24 e. Using or possessing marker pens, spray paint cans, knives, screwdrivers, razor
25 blades or nails for the purpose of applying graffiti or vandalizing property;

26 f. Spray painting or otherwise applying graffiti on any public or private property,
27 including but not limited to: the street; alley; residences; block walls; vehicles; and/or, any
28 other real or personal property;

g. Trespassing on any private property;

- 1 h. Placing bicycles, or motorized vehicles in a manner to obstruct the free passage
2 of any person or vehicle on: any street; walkway; sidewalk; driveway; alleyway; or, other area of
3 public passage;
- 4 i. Approaching vehicles, or otherwise communicating with the occupants of any
5 vehicle, for the purpose of obstructing or delaying the free flow of vehicular traffic as
6 described in V.C. §22500;
- 7 j. Discharging any firearms;
- 8 k. In any manner confronting, intimidating, annoying, harassing, threatening,
9 challenging, provoking, assaulting and/or battering any residents or patrons or visitors to the
10 Target Area or any persons who are known to have complained about gang activities;
- 11 l. Participating in the use, possession and/or sale of narcotics;
- 12 m. Being present in a vehicle found to have any contraband, narcotics, or illegal or
13 deadly weapons with knowledge of contraband, narcotics, or illegal or deadly weapons;
- 14 n. Possessing instruments commonly used for breaking into locked vehicles, with
15 the intent to do so, including but not limited to: picks; wire cutters; dent pullers; sling shots;
16 steel shots; spark plugs; “slim jims”;
- 17 o. Demanding entry into another person’s residence any time of the day or night;
- 18 p. Knowingly hiding people who are evading a law enforcement officer;
- 19 q. Signaling to, or whistling, to warn of the approach of police officers;
- 20 r. Urinating or defecating in any public place open to public view;
- 21 s. Using words, phrases, physical gestures, or symbols commonly known as hand
22 signs which describe or refer to the gang known as Posole, such as: placing the thumb and any
23 other finger together to form an “O” and extending any other finger or fingers to form a “P”;
24 separating and two fingers to form a “V”; placing the elbows together to form a “V”; placing the
25 hand of one arm on any part of the other arm to form a “P”; placing the hands, with the fingers
26 forming a half-circle, on top of each other to form the letter “S”;
- 27 t. Wearing clothing which bears the name or letters that spell out the name of the
28 gang known as Posole or associated with the gang known as Posole, such as, but not limited to,
any variations or combinations of: “Posole”; “Posoles”; “P”; “PT”; “M”, “Eme”; “Varrio

1 Posole”; “Varrío Posole Locos”; “Varrío Posole Loco”; “Posole Town”; “VP”; “VPL”; “VPLS”;
2 “13”; “20”; “13 20”; “16”; “16 20”; “22”; “22 16”; “ 22 16 12”; “22 16 12”; “22 16 12 19”;

3 u. Making, loud noise of any kind, including, but not limited to yelling and loud
4 music at any time of the day or night consistent with Oceanside City Code §§ 38 et seq.;

5 v. If under the age of eighteen (18), being in a public place between the hours of
6 10:00 p.m. on any day, and sunrise of the immediately following day, unless (1) accompanied
7 by a parent or legal guardian, or by a spouse eighteen (18) years of age or older, or (2)
8 performing an errand directed by a parent or legal guardian, or by a spouse eighteen (18) years
9 or older, or (3) returning directly home from a public meeting, or a

15 place of public entertainment, such as a movie, play, sporting event, dance or school, or (4)
16 actively engaged in some business, trade, profession, or occupation which requires such
