- No Association With Known Gang Member: Standing, sitting, walking, a. driving, gathering or appearing, anywhere in public view or any place accessible to the public, with any named Defendant herein or any known member of VARRIO POSOLE LOCOS, also known as "POSOLE," criminal street gang, but not including (1) when all individuals are inside a school attending class or on school business, and (2) when all individuals are inside a church, provided however that this prohibition against association shall apply to all claims of travel to or from any of those locations, and (3) any of the named defendants who are siblings, may appear together in public if they are accompanied by one of their parents;
- No Intimidation: Confronting, intimidating, annoying, harassing, threatening, challenging, provoking, assaulting, or battering any person known to be a witness to or victim of crime, or any person known to have complained about the gang activities of the VARRIO POSOLE LOCOS, also known as "POSOLE," criminal street gang;
- Stay Away From Drugs In Public: (1) Participating in the selling, possessing or using of any controlled substance, or illegal drug, including, but not limited to: heroin, cocaine, cocaine base, methamphetamine, and marijuana; (2) possession of related drug paraphernalia, including, but not limited to, rolling papers, pipes, or other devices used for injecting, smoking or ingesting illegal drugs; (3) knowingly remaining in the presence of anyone selling, possessing, or using any controlled substance or illegal drug without a prescription; or (4) being under the influence of a controlled substance, or illegal drug without a prescription;
 - d. Stay Away From Alcohol In Public: Anywhere in public view or anyplace

- No Guns or Dangerous Weapons: Anywhere in public view or anyplace accessible to the public, (1) possessing any weapons: firearms, including BB guns, airsoft guns, pellet guns, and replica guns, ammunition, knives, baseball bats, brass knuckles, or screwdrivers, without a legitimate purpose, or illegal weapon as defined in Penal Code section 12020, (2) knowingly remaining in the presence of anyone who is in possession of such gun, ammunition or dangerous weapon, or (3) knowingly remaining in the presence of such gun, ammunition or dangerous weapon;
- f. No Fighting: Engaging in fighting in public streets, alleys and/or public and private property;
- No Trespassing: Being present on any property not open to the general public, except with (1) the prior written consent of the owner, owner's agent, or the person in lawful possession of the property, or (2) in the presence of and with the voluntary consent of the owner, the owner's agent, or the person in lawful possession of the property;
- No Blocking Free Passage: Blocking the free passage of any person or vehicle on any street, walkway, sidewalk, driveway, alleyway, or other area of public passage;
- No Graffiti/Vandalism or Tools: (1) Spray painting, marking with marker pens, i. etching, or otherwise applying graffiti on any public or private property, or (2) possessing spray paint cans, marker pens or other objects capable of defacing property;
- No Acting as Lookouts: Acting as a lookout, whistling, yelling or otherwise j. signaling another person to warn of the approach or presence of law enforcement officers;
- k. No Gang Hand Signs: Using words, phrases, physical gestures, or symbols commonly known as hand signs, which describe or refer to the gang known as VARRIO POSOLE LOCOS, also known as "POSOLE," such as, placing the thumb and their index finger 29 together to form an "O" and extend any other finger or fingers to form a "P"; separate two

fingers to form a "V"; place the elbows together to form a "V"; place the hand of one arm on any part of the other arm to form a "P"; place the hands, with the fingers forming a half-circle, on top of each other to form the letter "S."

- No Gang Clothes: Wearing clothing or accessories which bear the name, initials, letters, numbers or other symbols of the gang known as VARRIO POSOLE LOCOS, including, but not limited to "Varrio Posole Locos;" "Posole;" "Oceanside Posole;" "P-Town;" "P;" "1620;" "Padres;" "Pittsburg Pirates;" "Eastside;" "VPLS;" "PT;" "16" and "20."
- m. **No Burglary Tools:** Possessing burglary tools with no legitimate purpose, including, but not limited to screwdrivers, shaved keys, spark plugs or porcelain casings, or other devices capable of being used to break into locked vehicles;
 - n. No Littering: Littering in any public place or place open to public view;
- o. **Juvenile Curfew:** If under the age of eighteen (18), being in a public place between the hours of 10:00 p.m. on any day, and 5:30 a.m. of the following day, unless (1) accompanied by a parent or legal guardian, or by a spouse eighteen (18) years of age or older, or (2) performing an errand directed by a parent or legal guardian, or by a spouse eighteen (18) years of age or older, or (3) returning directly home from a public entertainment, such as a movie, play, sporting event, dance or school activity, or (4) actively engaged in some business, trade, profession, or occupation which requires such presence.
- p. Removal Provision: Any person (hereinafter, "Served Person") who has been served with this injunction or any subsequent injunction entered in this action (hereinafter, "Gang Injunction") may move this Court (hereinafter, "Removal Provision"), to be dismissed from this action. This Gang Injunction shall not be enforceable against a Served Person who is dismissed under this Removal Provision. The terms of the current Removal Provision are as follows:
- 1. Requirements: Plaintiff agrees not to object to a Served Person's motion to be dismissed under this provision, so long as the dismissal is to be without prejudice and with each side to bear its own costs and fees, and so long as the motion satisfies the following requirements:
 - a. Proper Notice: A motion under this provision shall be made on proper

28 29 notice, properly served on plaintiff's counsel, and shall not be made on shortened time;

- b. Not/No Longer a Gang Member: Served Person must declare he/she is a reformed, former POSOLE gang member (or that he/she was never a POSOLE gang member), he/she is not active with the POSOLE gang, and he/she renounced the POSOLE gang and gang life. This declaration regarding POSOLE gang and gang life is an essential part of this provision; and
- c. Proof Required: (A) Served Person must declare that he/she has not been arrested for the past five years, not including any time spent incarcerated, which must be true; (B) Served Person must declare that he/she has not been documented by law enforcement for the past five years to have been in the company or association of any known active POSOLE gang member, other than an immediate family member, which must be true; (C) Served Person must declare that he/she has not been documented by law enforcement in violation of any of the above gang injunction provisions (D) Served Person must declare that he/she has not obtained any new POSOLE gang-related tattoos for the past five years, which must be true; and (E) Served Person must declare that he/she is gainfully employed and has so been employed consistently for a period of one year, which must be true or in the alternative, that Served Peron is enrolled in educational pursuits or doing community service which contributes to the benefit of their local community; and (E) Served Person must sign this declaration under penalty of perjury.
- d. No Third Party Beneficiaries: It shall not be a defense to any civil or criminal contempt charge or civil or criminal charge of any nature whatsoever, that any person including any Served Person was eligible to apply for dismissal under this provision.
- e. Effect in Other Proceedings: Plaintiff shall not be bound by the criteria of this Removal Provision (five arrest-free years, and other criteria), in any action, civil or criminal, other than a motion brought under this provision in this action. Moreover, a dismissal under this provision shall be without prejudice and shall not operate as a retraxit in any other action.
- f. Dismissed Served Person Committing New Violation: If a Served Person who has successfully been dismissed from this Gang Injunction pursuant to this Removal

1	Provision, fails to abide by all of the above "removal provisions," such as by association with
2	known active POSOLE gang members, by getting new gang tattoos, or by getting arrested for
3	any crime that is determined to be a gang-related crime, then such Served Person may be re-
4	served with this Gang Injunction, and will be required to comply with all of its terms;
5	2. Personal Service Required: No person shall be subject to the provisions of this
6	Order unless that person has been previously personally served with this Order.
